Summary: The fonds contains KSU's founding documents; Council, Executive and General meeting minutes; correspondence, financial records and budgets, reports, posters and publications. It includes records of KSU services and activities, as well as records documenting KSU's involvement in issues affecting student life. Most records are from the 1980-2000 period, but records dating to the 1890s as well as the present day, 2007, are also included in the fonds. This fonds includes the KSU records processed in 1993 by John Weeren.

Administrative history

1. Dates 1890-2007 (continuing)

The KSU is the governing student organization of the University of King's College in Halifax, Nova Scotia, and acts as the students' representative in improving academic and campus life experiences. It functions as a body of students elected to represent the interests of fellow students.

The King's Students' Union ("KSU") includes all students attending the University of King's College. Its purpose is to provide services for its members and represent them politically.

The KSU has members on the Board of Governors and on University committees, and works with the University administration to improve the quality of education and student life at College.

The services provided by the KSU include a health insurance plan, Orientation Week, the Student Handbook, the yearbook, and graduation week activities. The KSU also funds many different societies and committees and King's athletics. The KSU operates HMCS King's Wardroom, the campus lounge.

The KSU is governed by its members at general meetings, open forums where each member has an equal vote and right to participate in direct democracy. Between the two general meetings each year, Student Council acts as the governing body of the KSU. Council meetings are open to all KSU members, but the only people who may vote are the 17 elected representatives.

Students have operated on a collective basis from the early years of the University of King's College, which was founded in Windsor, Nova Scotia, in 1789. In 1806, students presented a memorial to the Board of Governors soliciting assistance in meeting their living expenses, obliged, as they then were, to provide their own servants. This was one of many petitions drawn up over the years. Other student organizations that were formed for the furtherance of particular objectives have a long history at King's, as well: the Quintilian, a debating society, was founded in 1845, and the Haliburton literary society was founded in 1884. Both continue today with financial support from the KSU.

The students of the University of King's College first organized themselves into a cohesive unit on October 10, 1890, in Commons Hall on the Windsor campus, to review the accounts of the Reading Room Association and elect officers for the Reading Room Association Committee.

Two weeks later, the students met again to review and approve a set of seven by laws. They met the following month to draw up a petition to the Board of Governors to alter the statute to allow students to be out after midnight.

There is no written history of student government at King's. However, an article by Dennis Walsh, B.A., Historian of the Haliburton Club, titled "Our Heritage ..." in *The Record*, 1968, pp. 46-48, states:

The Senior Student in the old days was officially appointed by the administration. The students submitted three names to the President in the order of preference, and the first name was usually chosen unless there was some reason that the administration thought that that person would not fulfill the office as well as one of the other names. In this way both the administration and the students were satisfied with the choice. The Senior Student was the representative of the students to the administration. The system that we now work under is only a few years old, and seems to have caused a rift in communications, although that is certainly not the only cause. . . .

Discipline did not seem to be as much of a problem in those days either. The students exercised their own discipline in their own manner. Fining powers were in the hands of the dons and Senior students. But these were very seldom used. Instead, the students themselves took care of any offenses. . . . Fines were last resorts or else were used by the dons or senior Student for the breaking of an official university ruling. A couple of such fines, and the student was promptly expelled.

The early role of the student government centred on managing the supervision of the campus library in Windsor during its student hours, which were a total of 90 minutes per week.

Other activities included regular meetings at which other committees were formed to handle student issues and interests, such as student justice and discipline. The predecessor of the Campus Police was a body of elected graduate students who collected inebriated underclassmen from the bars of Windsor each evening, all parties being garbed in academic gowns and mortarboards, pursuant to College policy. This group also maintained Commons Hall, the campus dining room, study area, and lounge.

2. Mandate/sphere of functional responsibility

The Society of the Students' Union of the University of King's College ("KSU") was incorporated as a society on February 21, 1969, and registered with the Nova Scotia Registry of Joint Stock Companies pursuant to the *Societies Act*, R.S.N.S. 1989, c.435.

The objects of the Students' Union, as expressed in the 2006 Constitution, are "to promote the general welfare of the members; to organize and to promote activities for and on behalf of its members; to provide the official organ for representing the students of the Union in relationship with (i) the faculty and administration of the University of King's College; (ii) other universities and student organizations; (iii) the general public and its official organizations."

The KSU also speaks for King's students on issues off campus. As Local 11 of the Canadian Federation of Students, it lobbies locally on national issues and participates in the CFS' annual Day of Action.

The first constitution, that of the Co-Ed Student Body, was adopted in 1953. Since then, there have been at least six revised constitutions, the latest in 2006. The seven articles in the first document seem modest in comparison with the 80 in the 2006 Constitution.

The KSU's mandate includes advocating for students' rights and providing services to members. These include administering the KSU Health Plan, which is negotiated through the Canadian Federation of Students; running a student pub, the Wardroom; and, most recently, encouraging the establishment of a bookstore on campus: the King's Bookstore Co-operative Limited was incorporated as a co-op association on August 8, 2006, with KSU President Dave Jerome on the board of directors.

The KSU is responsible for the annual production and printing of the College yearbook, *The Record*. The KSU also acts as an intermediary between students and the University administration or the Board of Governors. The administration views the KSU as being representative of the opinions of the King's student body as a whole, and frequently consults the Executive for advice on student matters.

The KSU has lobbied against tuition fee increases and for improved access to University buildings for students with disabilities. It supplies students with information about provincial and national elections and issues.

The KSU hosts an orientation early in September for new students: Frosh Week. KSU also host an awards banquet at the end of the school year.

During the summer months, the KSU office is open, staffed by a hired summer office manager, usually one of the Executive members.

3. Predecessor and successor bodies

Almost four decades after female students were admitted to King's College in 1893, the Co-Ed Council was formed in 1932 to represent the interests of female students. (The Co-Ed Council should not be confused with the Co-Ed Club, also called the Co-Ed Association, that was active from 1913-1967.) In 1965, the Co-Ed Council merged with the Men's Students' Council, the modern KSU was formed, and the students elected their first President.

4. Administrative relationships

As an incorporated society, KSU is autonomous from the University administration. However, the KSU relies on the University for its operating budget, which is funded by fees of \$156 per student (2007-2008) that the University deducts from incidental fees and remits to the KSU. The budget supports a wide range of free or non-profit services and events for students, as well as funding for 40 student societies in 2006-2007.

The KSU gained representation on the University's Board of Governors by ss. 6(2)(1) and (m) of the *King's College Act*, S.N.S. 1998, c.44, which provide that the Board of Governors

includes the President of the Student Union and two student representatives elected by the Student Union.

The KSU also sends representatives to make presentations to Faculty meetings on various matters, and has members on some University committees.

The KSU hires the Wardroom manager, who in recent years has not been a student. KSU also hires students for a number of positions.

Union-hired positions (honoraria for 2007-2008):

Campus Safety Coordinator: responsible for administering the KSU's Campus Safety program: used to run the Walk Home program, which no longer exists; provides condoms and other prophylactics. \$750, at discretion of Council.

Chair of the Union: responsible for chairing meetings of the Union's Council, as well as adjudicating constitutional disputes and rule-based election appeals. \$200.

Chief Returning Officer: responsible for chairing the KSU's Elections Committee and for organizing and adjudicating fall Council elections and February executive/BOG elections. \$200.

CUBE Coordinator: responsible for organizing and running the KSU's intramural sports program: booking gym time, advertising. \$400, at discretion of Council.

Events Coordinator: chairs the KSU's Events Committee; responsible for organizing at least two events for King's students per term. Past events have included a fundraising walk for AIDS research, Safe Sex Awareness Week, the famous Three-Legged Race, and Oktoberfest. \$400, at discretion of Council.

Handbook Editor: produces the local content of the KSU's Student Handbook: writing a section on Halifax life, collecting information helpful to King's students. \$500, at discretion of Council; also commission on advertising sales.

Health Plan Administrator: administers the health plan: processing claims and dealing with health plan provider. \$1,250, at discretion of Council. The first Health Plan Administrator was hired in the 1998-1999 academic year. Prior to that, health insurance was provided through the KSU and administered by a Vice President.

KSU Sound Tech (possibly a new name for Stereo Manager).

Orientation Week Coordinators: prepare and run Frosh Week activities for new students. Usually done by two people. \$3,000 honorarium, split as agreed between the Coordinators, at the discretion of Council.

Scribe: new position created in 2006-2007 to take notes at meetings.

Summer Office Manager: administers KSU office over the summer months, answering enquiries, overseeing KSU employees, dealing with University administrators, paying bills. Preference given to Executive members or students who are heavily involved with the KSU. \$2,500 over the course of the summer (2007).

Yearbook Editor: edits *The Record*; takes photographs, solicits articles and advertising, lays out pages, liaises with publishers. \$1,750 honorarium, at discretion of Council.

5. Administrative structure

Membership

All King's students are members of the KSU; membership cannot be waived. By art.2 of the 2006 constitution, all students registered at King's for one or more credits and who have paid the Students' Union Fee (\$156 for 2007-2008) shall be members of the KSU. Students remain members of the KSU until they graduate, so long as they are registered.

Council

Elected annually, the Council is composed of the five Executive officers (President, Internal Vice President, Financial Vice President, External Vice President, Communication Vice President) and 12 Councillors representing various constituencies within the student body.

During the Council meetings, which occur about every two weeks throughout the academic year, motions are tabled and discussions occur regarding the issues and events behind the motions.

The Student Council is responsible for the day-to-day management of student affairs at King's, a role that involves it in a wide range of tasks, from the administration of a health plan to the administration of a lounge. While the focus of the Student Council is naturally on King's, it has formal links with the leadership of other students' unions through the Students' Union of Nova Scotia and the Canadian Federation of Students, umbrella organizations which promote the collective interests of students.

Councillors

First Year Representative: represents interests and concerns of first-year students, making special efforts to inform and involve them in the King's community and the KSU.

Arts Representative: handles concerns of all students enrolled in Arts programs and also sits as a voting member of the Dalhousie Arts and Social Science Society, where she/he represents King's interests.

Science Representative: handles specific concerns of all students in Science programs and also sits as a voting member of the Dalhousie Science Society, where she/he represents King's interests.

Journalism Representative: handles concerns of all students in the four-year honours Journalism program.

One-Year Journalism Representative: handles concerns of all students in the one-year B.J. Journalism program.

Board of Governors Representatives (two positions): sit, together with the KSU President, on the Board of Governors, the supreme governing body of the University, when it meets four times per year. The KSU representatives' presence ensures that the students' voice is heard when important University decisions are made.

Member At Large: a watchdog on KSU activities; position is not affiliated with any program because it is meant to represent the student community at King's as a whole.

Chair of Bays (Residence Representative): represents students who live in the Bays of King's residence (North Pole, Cochran, Radical, Chapel, Middle, Angel's Roost); has a budget from the University to put on events for Bay students or to purchase items requested by students or deemed necessary for Bay residents' convenience. The Chair of Bays meets once a semester with the Floor Reps and Dons of each Bay to discuss Bay issues. Together with the Alex Hall President, the Chair of Bays organizes Study Snacks, bi-weekly events that coincide with FYP Weekends, where FYP students meet, receive free snacks and coffee, and discuss their FYP essays.

Alexandra Hall President (Residence Representative): duties are similar to those of the Chair of Bays, only her/his constituents are the residents of Alexandra Hall; sits on Council, has a budget to purchase items for Alex Hall, organizes Student Snacks every FYP Sunday.

Day Students' Society Representatives (two positions): represent aims and opinions of Day Students (students registered at King's but who do not live in campus residences).

Chair: not a voting member, but plays a vital role in facilitating the smooth execution of all Council meetings by ensuring that the proceedings take place in an amicable and respectful environment and according to Robert's Rules of Order; interprets the Constitution in the event that a constitutional concern arises; also decides election appeals.

Executive

The KSU Executive is five elected officers who are responsible for implementing the Council's directions and managing the day-to-day operations of the KSU. The President is the elected leader of KSU. Each of the four Vice Presidents is charged with duties relating to a specific portfolio, and each chairs a committee that oversees funding disbursements to committees or activities relating to that Vice President's jurisdiction.

Each Executive member receives a salary (\$2,800 in 2006-2007), and although she or he may take classes, each considers his/her position to be the equivalent of a full time job and most Executive officers are unable to take a full course load. At one point in its history, KSU provided funds for the summer tuition for the President, who would be unable to take enough courses in the

school year, but this is no longer the case.

President: role is the least defined in the Constitution; serves as the face of the entire Union and devotes a large amount of time to meeting with representatives of other student unions and any other body that has dealings with the Union. The President's most important task is to ensure that all the other councilors fulfil their duties, and to offer support if they require assistance. The President has responsibility for the Wardroom, King's on-campus lounge, and is the third student representative on the University's Board of Governors.

Communications Vice President: maintains and distributes agendas and minutes for each council meeting, updates bulletin boards around campus to inform students about the activities of the Union and the school as a whole, and issues the weekly newsletter, *This Week At King's* ("TWAK"), which lists campus events by day for each week of the school year. The CVP is responsible for much of the content on the KSU website, and supervises the Handbook and website editors. The position of Secretary existed from 1890 until 1991. In the 1991-1992 academic year, the position of Communications Vice-President was instituted and replaced the position of Secretary. In 2006-2007, the CVP relinquished the nearly-impossible duties of keeping minutes while simultaneously participating in meetings, and the KSU created the position of Scribe to take minutes.

External Vice President: position created in the 1965-1966 academic year; concerned with external affairs that affect the student population at King's. The EVP sits on the External Action Committee, which raises awareness of important issues such as tuition fees and participates in community activism. The EVP sits on the Canadian Federation of Students (CFS), which pushes for government action against rising tuition fees in Nova Scotia and Canada as a whole. The EVP is interested in social justice and is networked to many different activist groups that can help students address anything from tenancy rights to gender/sexual/racial discrimination. The EVP's area of concern is programs that benefit the community at large, the Canadian Federation of Students, and community activism.

Financial Vice President: position created in 1991-1992, superceding the position of Treasurer, which existed from 1965-1991. From 1890 to 1965, funding of the Union was through the administration and less money was required, due to smaller operations during the period before amalgamation. The FVP deals with KSU's budget and funding for student societies. She/he is responsible for the care and custody of the funds of the KSU and maintains complete and accurate accounting books. The FVP is also responsible for arranging the annual audit of the KSU's finances by an accounting firm. Cheques must be signed by the FVP and the IVP or President. The FVP meets as often as necessary with the Finance Committee to discuss society funding. The FVP also supervises the Health Plan Administrator and the Yearbook Editor. The FVP sits on *The Watch* Publishing Board. The KSU grants money (from *The Watch* levy in student fees) to *The Watch*, but can withhold or reduce the amount depending on the paper's performance or standards.

Internal Vice President: position was created in the 1965-1966 academic year. The IVP assumes the duties of the President in the absence or incapacity of the President. The IVP's main responsibility is student societies and is the conduit for communication between societies and the KSU. The IVP must be familiar with the status of old and new societies, and directly approves ratification of each society, thus approving funding. The IVP also oversees the K-Points system

and supervises the Campus Safety, CUBE and Events Coordinators. The IVP also regulates the use of the name "King's" in society names: only societies that have been ratified by the KSU are permitted to use "King's" in their names.

At the time of writing, KSU has its first all-female Executive: 2007-2008 President Coren Pulleyblank, External Vice President Kaley Kennedy, Internal Vice President Judy Booth, Communications Vice President Victoria O'Neill, and Financial Vice President Lara Haines-Love.

Committees

KSU has standing and ad-hoc committees. Each committee is expected to report to Council once a month. The committees listed below, except for Financial, don't actually function; they act as umbrella committees for any committees arising under their jurisdiction and funded by them. KSU has found that it is easier to direct money to four large committees at the start of the Council year than to continually fund committees throughout the year.

Communications Committee: run by the Communications Vice President; its budget allocation is for use by any committee that is created for communications. This committee also oversees publicity for the KSU, including publishing posters.

Executive Committee: primarily a contingency committee (in a financial and practical sense) and usually does not meet, although funds are budgeted for it. Each Executive officer is a member of this committee and may use its funds as contingency funding for their own portfolio.

External Committee: run by the External Vice President; funds allotted to this committee can be used by any committee that is created to deal with external matters.

Finance Committee: run by the Financial Vice President, this is the most active committee. Its mandate is to fund student societies; the only committee that meets regularly – it meets weekly during the busy period of September and October, when societies are being ratified; frequency of meetings decreases later in the year.

Internal Committee: Internal Vice President oversees this committee, which is allotted funding to distribute to any committee that is created for internal issues or activities, i.e., the issues relating most directly to students themselves, such as awards.

6. Name

Prior to its incorporation, the student government was called the **Student Body of King's College**, and was informally referred to as "The Students." This name may reflect the subordination of the student body to the University administration.

From 1932-1965, the **Men's Student Council** and the **Co-Eds' Council** represented the interests of the male and female students respectively.

In 1965, the two Councils merged, forming the **King's Students' Union**.

The registered name on the certificate of incorporation issued February 21, 1969, is **The Society of the Students' Union of the University of King's College**. The King's Students' Union has been commonly known on campus as "the KSU" since 1965, and is often referred to in its own publications as "the Union."

7. Chief officers

The title of the King's student government's chief officer changed over the decades, from Senior or Senior Student in 1890, to Men's Senior Student and Senior Co-Ed (simultaneous offices) in 1932, to the current title of President in 1965. The first President elected by students was John William Cleveland in 1965, making him the first President of the KSU in its present form.

The KSU has not maintained a historical list of its Executive officers and councillors, so during the course of the 2007 Young Canada Works summer grant project, Archives Assistant Jonathan Borden compiled the following list of KSU's leaders from 1890-2008 from the KSU records:

8. Other information

Office space

The KSU's office was in a room directly under the steps of the Administration Building from the late 1960s until the late 1970s, in the area now occupied by the Wardroom. When the Wardroom opened in 1979, the KSU moved to the room formerly occupied by the Institute of Pastoral Training on the first floor of North Pole Bay, adjacent to the living room of the Don's suite.

The KSU's office remained in North Pole Bay until the New Academic Building ("NAB") was constructed and a link was built that attached the NAB to the Administration Building. New office space for the KSU was created in the link and the KSU officers moved to their larger and modern premises in 2003. KSU was given this office space pursuant to a Deed of Donation whereby the KSU donated funds to the University to help construct the NAB.

After the KSU vacated its premises in North Pole Bay, that room became the Junior Common Room.

The KSU year

The KSU Council's annual cycle, according to 2007-2008 Financial Vice President Lara Haines-Love in an interview on July 12, 2007, is as follows:

- February Nominations, campaigning, speeches and elections of Executive officers and Board of Governor representatives; the Chief Returning Officer from the previous fall elections presides over the elections.
- March 15 New Council takes office
Filling of Union-hired positions begins as soon as the new Executive is installed: positions are advertised, search committees formed that make recommendations to Council. The King's Student Union hired positions are Campus Safety Coordinator, Chair of the Union, CUBE Coordinator, Events Coordinator, Handbook Editor, Health Plan Administrator, KSU sound tech, Orientation Week Coordinators,

Scribe, Summer Office Manager, and Yearbook Editor.

March/April Elections for other councillors, run not by the CRO but by the incumbent in each position: Chair of Bays; Day Student' Society executive; Alexandra Hall President

August 31 KSU's fiscal year-end; changed from March 31 because it was difficult for the incoming FVP to deal with an unfamiliar budget and audit, as because of liability issues – a new FVP being held accountable for problems she/he was not responsible for creating.

Late September/early October

Elections are held for the following councillors as soon as possible in the academic year: First Year Representative, Arts Representative, Science Representative, Member-at-Large, B.J. Honours Representative and B.J. one-year programme Representative. Any member of the student union is eligible to run for these positions; the student's year doesn't matter except for the First Year rep position. The yearbook, *The Record*, is usually published in the fall. In recent years, the KSU ordered 450 copies of the yearbook, but in 2007-2008, the system will be changed to a user-pay.

Health Plan

The Canadian Federation of Students administers the health plan through its branch, the National Student Health Network. The insurer for KSU and other CFS members has been Greenshield since about 2003. The KSU's broker is Morneau-Sebeco, who succeeded Heath Lambert.

Students may opt out from participating in the health plan. When the deadline has passed, the Health Plan Administrator compiles a list of students who are opting out and sends this list to the Bursar, who refunds opt-out students on Students Accounts. The Bursar sends the list of students who will be using the health plan to the broker. The KSU cannot see this list due to privacy laws.

Scope and content

The fonds contains the minutes of most of the KSU Executive, Council and general meetings for over a century, from 1890-2007. It contains documentation of the special projects KSU initiated, such as Walk Home and the Wardroom.

Because there were no clear series of correspondence in the records, most correspondence has been placed in topical folders.

An important part of the fonds is the Student Societies series, KSU.9. Student societies have a long history at King's College, beginning with the Quintilian, founded in 1845, Canada's oldest debating society and the oldest collegiate society in North America still extant. Modern societies reflecting the diverse interests of students include Free the Children, Volunteer Tutoring,

St. Andrew's Missionary Society, and the King's Anime and Manga Palooza society. The fonds contains records documenting the activities of more than 100 King's student societies, including the Quintilian Debating Society, 1845-2007; The Haliburton literary society, 1884-2007; King's Theatrical Society, 1931-2007.

The fonds includes nearly complete runs of the major student newspapers, *The Ancient Commoner* (1965-1988) and *The Watch*. There are also copies of the Student Handbook from 1966 to 2006. Note: *The Record*, which began as a monthly student magazine in 1879 and became the modern-day yearbook in 1951, has been catalogued and is in Special Collections; the Archives has duplicate uncatalogued copies of almost every issue.

The fonds consists of the records created, received and collected by the King's Students' Union in the course of administering the student government and carrying out its business and activities. The fonds includes the founding documents of the KSU, its constitutions, by-laws and policies; minutes of meetings of its Executive, Council, and general membership; financial records, including audited financial statements, budgets, ledger sheets, contracts, and invoices; records related to KSU's operations and its activities, including elections, activism, participation on university committees, liaison with other university student organizations such as the Canadian Federation of Students, Students' Union of Nova Scotia (incorporated 1984, lapsed 1998), and the Dalhousie University Student Union; and the records of the many student societies that have existed at the University of King's College; correspondence, reports, by-laws, newspaper clippings, artifacts and other materials.

Most of the material dates from the period 1980-2000.

Custodial History

There has been no regular deposit schedule for KSU records. The early KSU minute books were deposited in the Library some decades ago. The bulk of the fonds arrived in several deposits when outgoing KSU Executive officers cleared out their office during the late 1990s and early 2000s.

Source of supplied title

Title based on provenance and contents of the fonds.

Arrangement

Because the KSU has no formal record-keeping system, there was no apparent arrangement to the records other than in the early minute books, which were maintained in chronological order.

Archivist John Weeren had arranged and described five boxes of KSU records in 1993. Since then, more than 25 boxes of additional KSU materials have arrived in the Archives. Because the subsequently-acquired material was unorganized, the Assistant Archivist and Archives Assistants imposed order on them. John Weeren's arrangement did not conform to the scheme devised in the current project, so the records he had arranged were disseminated among the new series. The Archives Assistants handled every piece of paper in the course of the 2007 YCW

summer grant project.

Materials extraneous to the fonds have been removed. These materials include duplicates, University records held elsewhere in the Archives and not created by KSU, and materials not created by KSU and not relevant to the fonds.

The fonds is arranged into nine hierarchical series by function, with the founding documents being in the first series, governance in the second, then financial, operational and administrative records, then relations with external entities, specialized activities, and finally, student societies, some of which pre-date the existence of student government at King's but which now, if still in existence, are funded by the KSU. Records within each series are ordered chronologically or alphabetically, as appropriate. Correspondence has been filed with its topic, in order to collect all material relating to a particular subject in one place.

Restrictions on access and use

All records are open except for sub-series KSU.5.3, which is closed because the records contain personal information.

Accruals

All accessions as of July 2007 have been processed. The fonds is open and further accruals are expected annually.

Related material

The University of King's College Library's Special Collections contains catalogued copies of *The Record* (the student magazine that later became the yearbook).

The Presidents' Papers contain correspondence with the KSU.

Immediate source of acquisition

The records in the fonds were deposited at irregular intervals, being transferred from the KSU office to the Archives in batches at the end of the term of office of various KSU Executives. Outgoing KSU President Matt Aronson transferred a significant number of records in 2000. Incoming KSU President Coren Pulleyblank transferred some records in April 2007.

Custodial history

University Archivist Drake Petersen deposited the early minute books in 1992, transferring them from the Library archives to the University Archives. The other records were transferred from the KSU offices to the Archives from time to time; there is no regular transfer schedule.

Administrative history

National student representation at King's has existed since the 1960s, when the Canadian Union of Students was represented at King's by a Chairman and Council. Members of this council also served on the KSU, but CUSK was a separate division.

The KSU has been a member of a number of national and regional student organizations. It belonged to the Atlantic Federation of Students ("AFS"), which was formed in 1975 as a union of students from 12 universities and colleges in Atlantic Canada. The AFS was associated with the National Union of Students (NUS), which emerged in 1972 from the previous Canadian Union of Students (CUS), formed in the late 1920s. Internal and external conflicts led to the AFS disbanding, and in 1978, student representatives from 11 Nova Scotia post-secondary institutions met in Halifax to found a provincial organization to replace it, the Students' Union of Nova Scotia ("SUNS").

Today, the KSU is Local 11 of the Canadian Federation of Students ("CFS"), and every student is a member of CFS. CFS works locally, provincially, and nationally toward the elimination of barriers to quality post-secondary education that exist as a result of finances, class, gender, race, sexual orientation, and regional disparity. Its activities include education and awareness campaigns, lobbying government representatives, and political actions. CFS is also affiliated with many other social justice organizations in Halifax, in Nova Scotia, and across the country.

KSU has ties to other student governments, exchanging correspondence with Dalhousie Students' Union and others.

Scope and content

The series consists of records documenting the KSU's involvement with organizations outside of the King's community, including student movement and advocacy groups at national, regional and provincial levels, as well as communications with governments at each of those levels. This series also includes records of relations between the KSU and other Canadian students' unions.

Files may include correspondence, publications, dues notices and invoices, handouts, meeting minutes of each organization, policies, posters, campaign material, press clippings, etc. Records by scope of organization (national to local), then chronologically within each organization.

Administrative history

H.M.C.S. King's Wardroom is the King's College student bar and the center of social life at King's. Names in honor of the part King's played in World War II, when the campus was leased to the Canadian Navy as a training facility for young officers to take short courses in navigation, it is located in the basement of the administration building. Activities include Moosehead Mondays, games of pool and foosball, and live music.

Over the course of the year, the Wardroom, in cooperation with the Day Students' Society and KSU, offers a wide range of events, such as DJs, open mics, Karaoke, coffee houses, and pool and foosball tournaments. The Wardroom has a wet-dry license that allows underage King's students to be inside the bar and participate in events. The Wardroom fosters a sense of community among King's students and welcomes all students, whether first-year students in the Foundation Year Programme or a fourth-year students in Journalism.

The KSU hires only one Wardroom position, the Wardroom manager. The current manager (2006-2007) is a food services industry professional; he has a connection to downtown Halifax's Chives Restaurant. The Wardroom manager hires all other Wardroom personnel.

The KSU pays for insurance and occasional repairs for the Wardroom. The relationship between the KSU, the Wardroom Board of Management, the Day Students' Society, and the University's food services is complicated: each party has an interest in the space, but individual responsibilities are not clear and do not seem to be fairly distributed.

Scope and content

The series consists of textual records relating to the running of the H.M.C.S. Wardroom, the student pub. Time allotted for this grant project does not permit this series to be arranged and described during this project, so these records will be processed at a later date.

Administrative history

Administrative history

Societies are an integral part of campus life at King's. While many universities' student societies are limited to department-specific groups, "societies at King's range from the properly pretentious Haliburton Society to the outrageous King's Theatrical Society, and the quirky King's Anime and Manga Palooza," according to the KSU website. Early each academic year, Societies file documents with the KSU to become ratified and thus be eligible for funding. Societies are also required to follow the bylaws of the KSU and are subject to policy decisions made by Council and the Internal Vice President.

Society meetings and events are advertised in the KSU weekly newsletter, TWAK (This Week at King's), which is e-mailed and posted in paper format on campus bulletin boards.

Scope and content

The series consists of materials produced by many of the Student Societies that have flourished at King's. Among them are the minute books of the oldest college debating society in North America the Quintilian, founded in 1845; North America's longest standing collegial literary society, the Haliburton, established in 1884; a lively dramatic society, King's Theatrical Society, founded in 1931, the largest per capita student theatre society in North America; the Day Students' Society; and numerous student groups reflecting the special interests of King's College students over the years, such as the ____, the ____, and the ____.

Although the oldest societies pre-date the KSU, they have been included here because they are now funded by KSU.

The files include publications issued by a society.
